<b>Class 1</b>	Explosive substances *
<b>Class 2</b>	Gases
<b>Class 3</b>	Flammable liquids
<b>Class 4</b>	Flammable solids
<b>Class 5</b>	Oxidising agents and organic peroxides
<b>Class 6</b>	Toxic substances
<b>Class 7</b>	Radio-active materials *
<b>Class 8</b>	Corrosive substances
<b>Class 9</b>	Miscellaneous dangerous substances

\* Driver must hold a special licence on top of the ADR licence to carry class 1 / class 7.
